- → Mentioned groups trained in modern teaching, learning, extension and scientific methods.
- → Mentioned groups trained in selected thematic fields of the curriculum.
- → An MA curriculum in the field of conservation / organic agriculture that can serve as prototype for developing further curricula at the university.
- → Students enrolled in MA programme finished already first semesters.
- → Farmers trained by staff of the university.
- → Increased productivity in the smallholder farms.

With these activities, the project will contribute to the government's efforts in the development of rural areas and in improving the environment, living conditions, coping strategies for climate change and to contribute to food security and employment in rural areas. In the meantime the project aims at integrating the SDGs.
