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## Israeli HE System - Snapshot

* 310,000 students (50\% of cohort) in 64 institutions:
- 9 Universities (Public)
- 55 Colleges (42 Public; 13 Private)
* Shanghai ranking: 2 HEIs in Top100, 3 in Top500
* No. 7 in citations / paper (\#1 in CS; \#3 in Engineering)
* 12 Nobel prizes (6 chemistry; 2 economics); 3 Turing
awards; 1 Fields medal


## Governance of the Israeli Higher Education System



## The Council for Higher Education (CHE)



## The Planning and Budgeting Committee - PBC

Plans the development of the HE system at the national level, taking into account both academic and national needs


Negotiates with the Ministry of Finance the share of higher education in the state budget.


Allocates the budget to the HE institutions (HEI's)


Examines requests to open new institutions \& new academic programs from the planning and budgetary points of view

Ensures that institutional budgets are balanced and executed according to plan while ensuring the HEI's solvency
