

- National Qualifications Framework Development implemented for a series of domains





Republic of Moldova **joined Tempus in 1994.** From 1994 to 2013 **83 projects** (including pre-projects), worth **in total 43 mln Euro**, were implemented.

22 of the 31 Moldovan higher education institutions have been involved in **Tempus/ Erasmus+** projects


