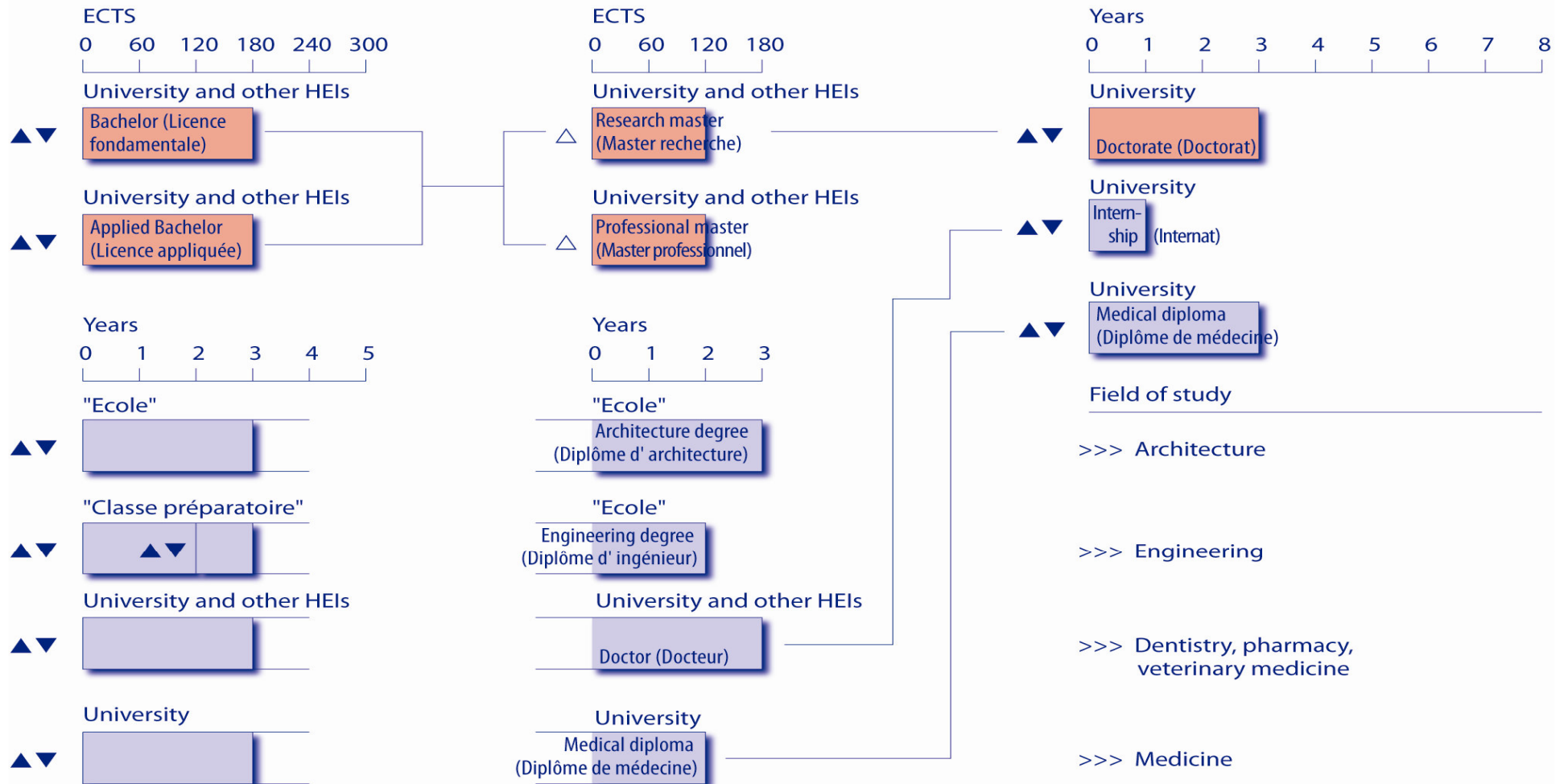

### Private HEIs:

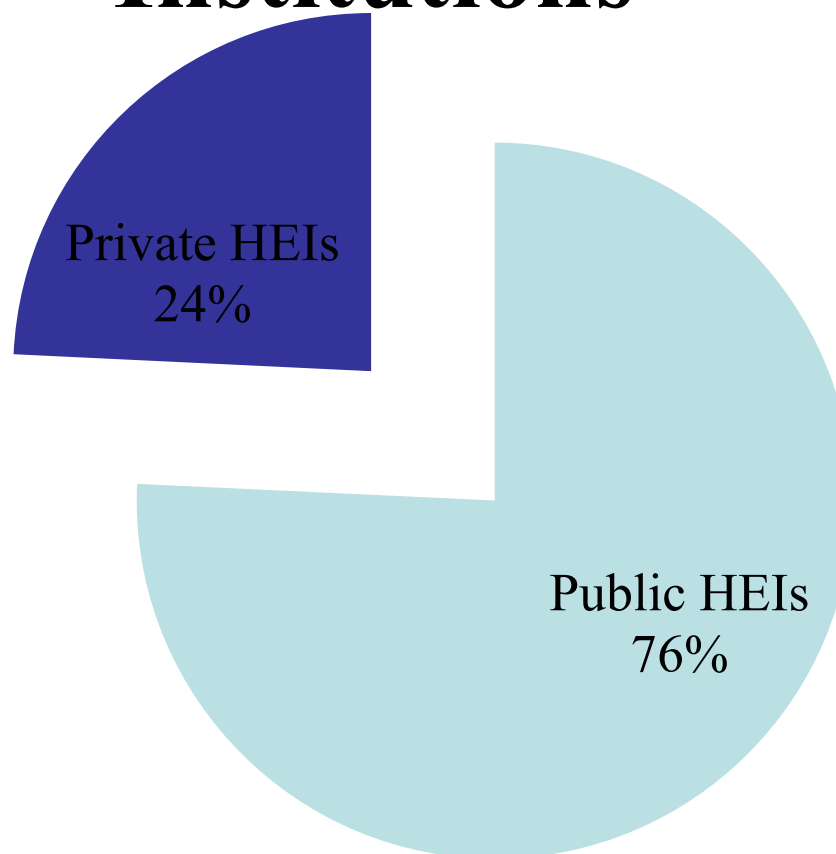

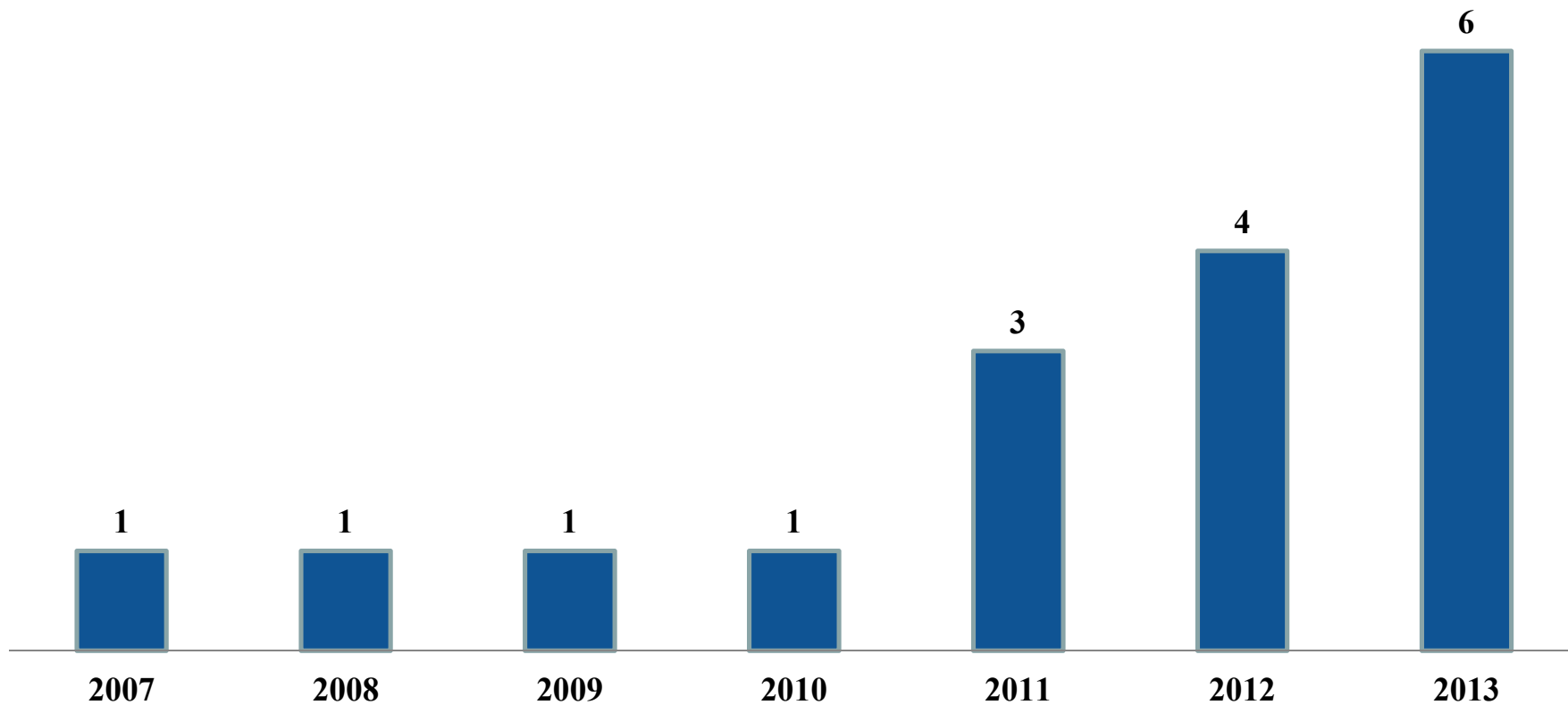

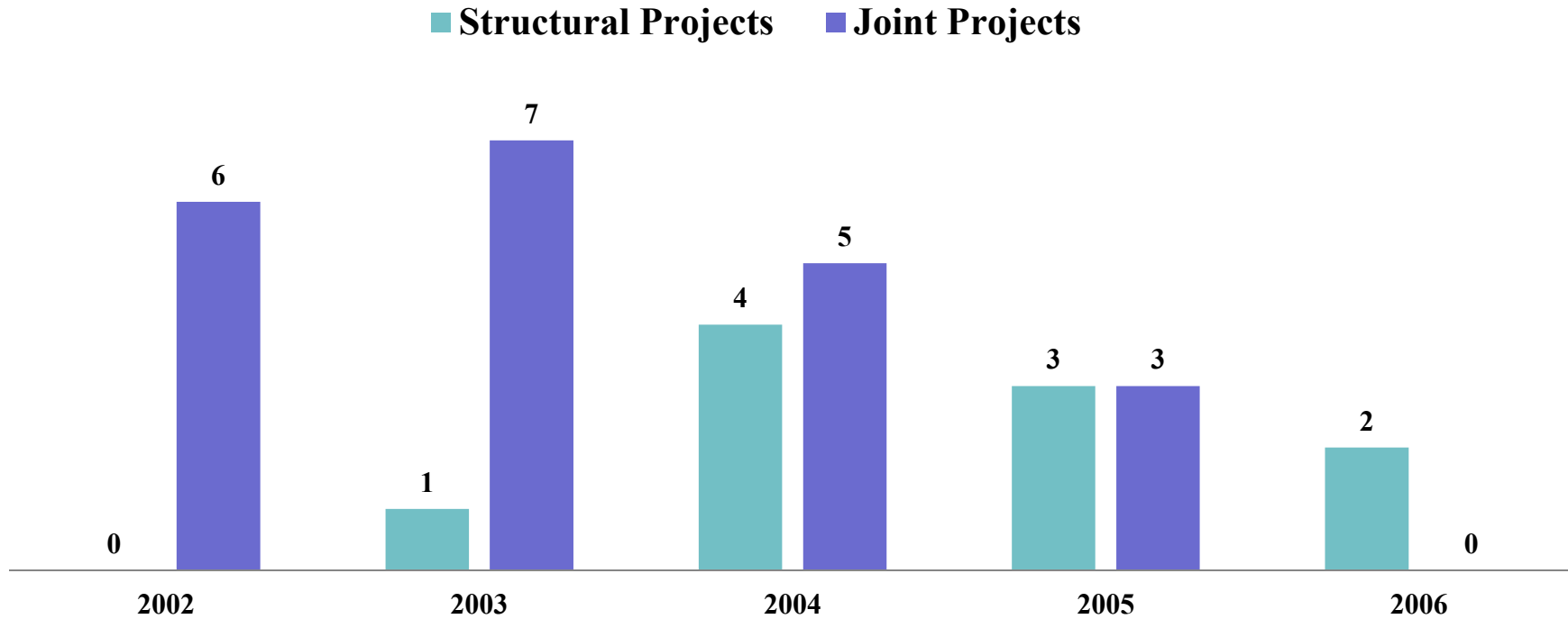

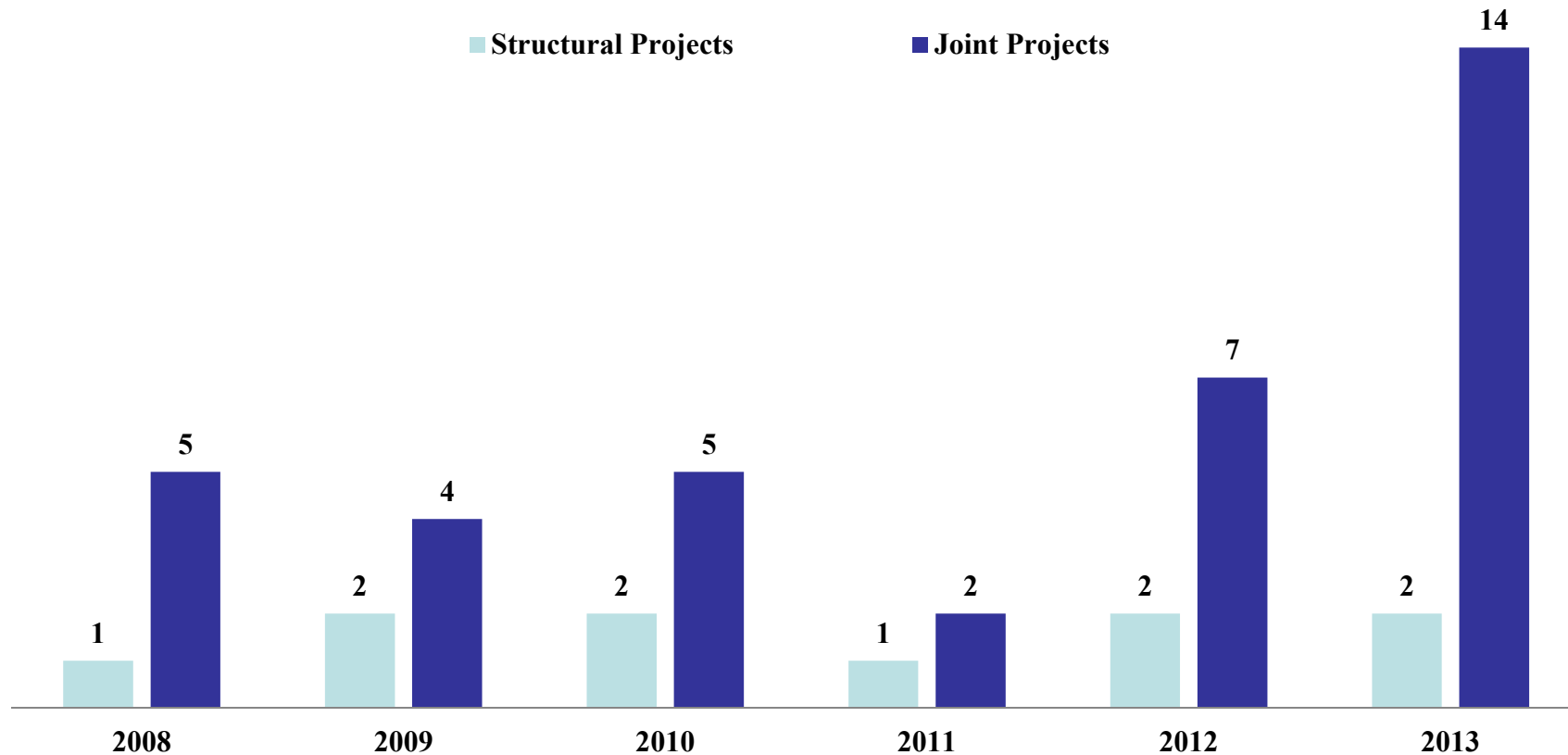

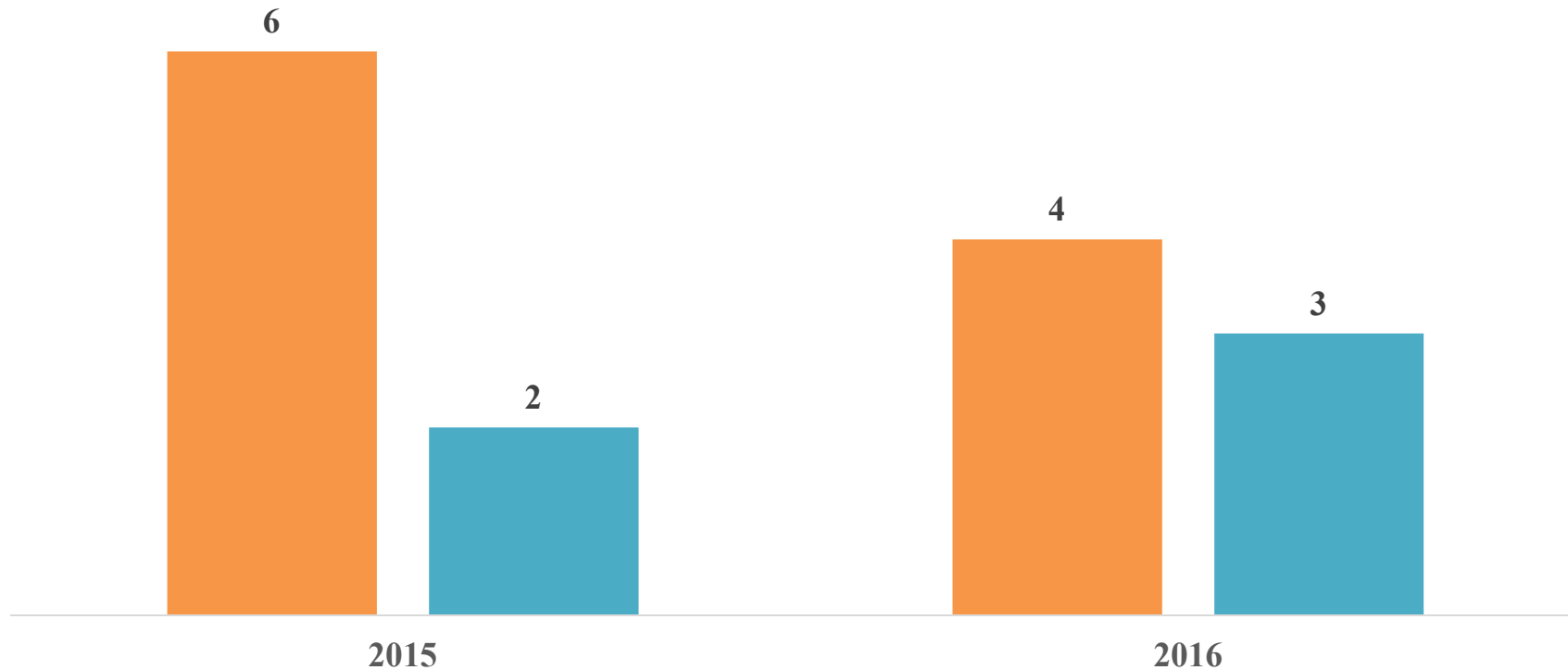

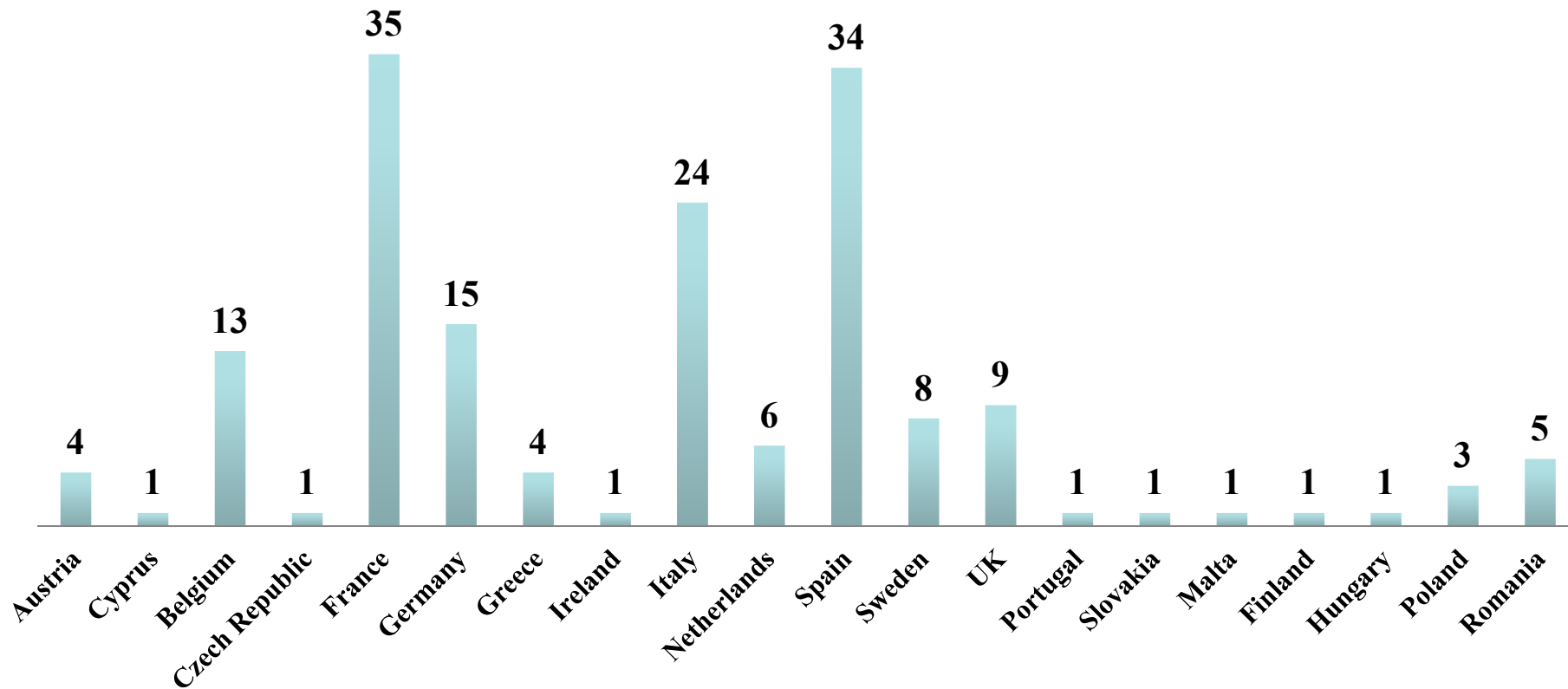

## Tunisia's Cooperation with Programme countries Tempus IV (2008-2013)

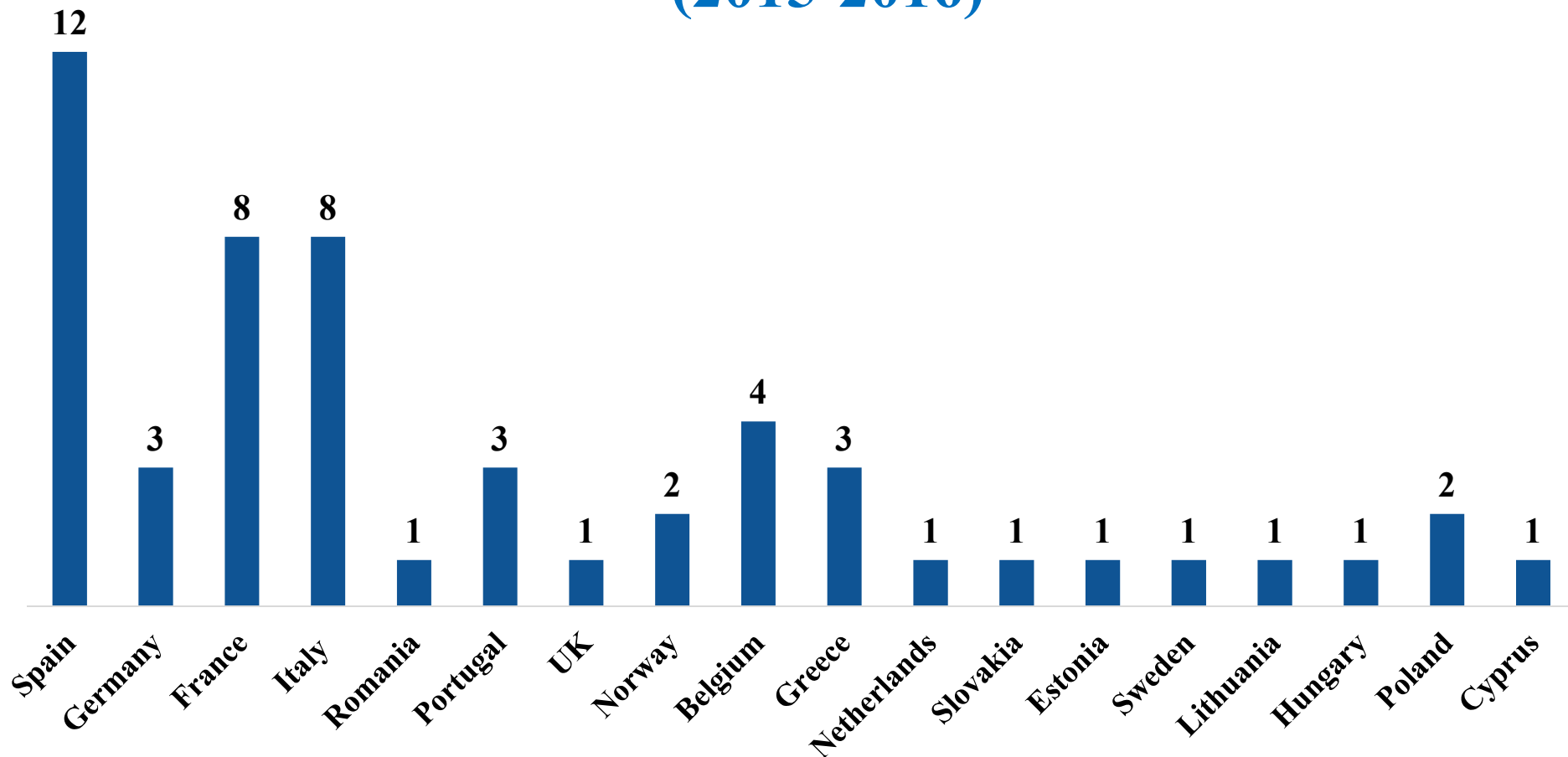
