What is it?

- 'One College, two campuses': in **Bruges** and in **Natolin** (Warsaw);
- Established in Bruges in 1949 in the wake of the first Congress of the European Movement in The Hague in 1948;
- Idea to establish an institute where university graduates from many different European countries (and beyond) could study and live together in preparation for careers related to European cooperation and integration;
- After the end of the 'Cold War', establishment of the Natolin campus in Warsaw to widen the perspective on and embrace European integration as a whole;
- International community of more than 50 nationalities;
- Bilingual institution: English French;
- Extensive network of alumni in Brussels and beyond (16.000 alumni).



GENERAL ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- All applicants to the College of Europe must hold a relevant university degree;
- Admission requires either a Bologna Master's degree / 240 ECTS;
- In excpetional cases, holders of a Bachelor degree can also be eligible;
- > English and French are required (level may vary according to the study programme).

N.B: Specific academic requirements apply for each study programme

- Online application by the deadline (no fees charged)
 - Transcripts & CV
 - Competences & activities
 - Motivation letter
 - Two recommendation letters

MARCH TO MAY

Invitation for an interview in your home country or via videocall

MAY TO JUNE

> Selection/admission decision (with possible conditions)

MAY TO JULY

Scholarship / payment information

AUGUST/SEPTEMBER

> Start of the academic year (possibly introductory courses)
