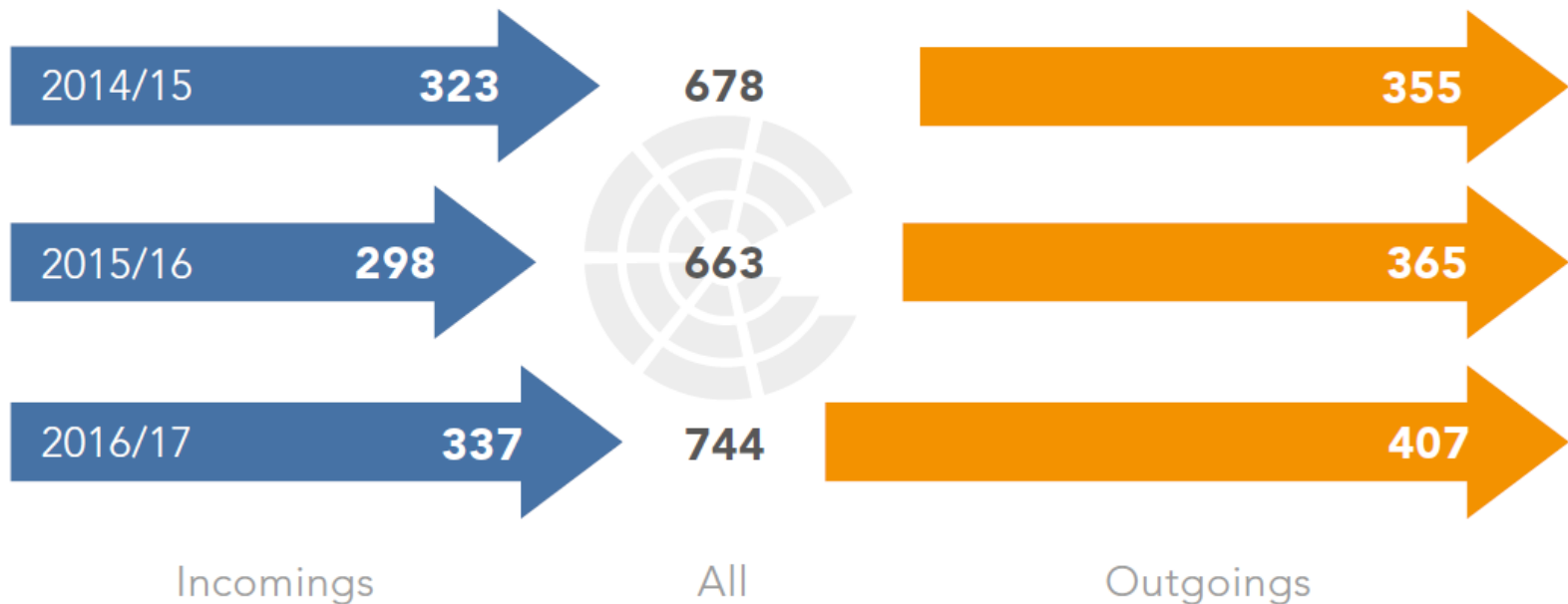

- Partner Institution
 - National Research University – Higher School of Economics (HSE)

Erasmus+ KA107 with HSE

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Partnership MCI – HSE

- Cooperation started in 2012 – visit of HSE faculty member at MCI
- Bilateral Agreement signed in 2014
- Strong cooperation between MCI's Department of „Entrepreneurship & Tourism“ and HSE's Master program in „Experience Economy: Hospitality and Tourism Management“
- April 2015: MCI presented a paper in „Leadership networks in community destinations“ at HSE's International Academic Conference on Economic and Social Development

- Short term study tours (2-3 weeks)
