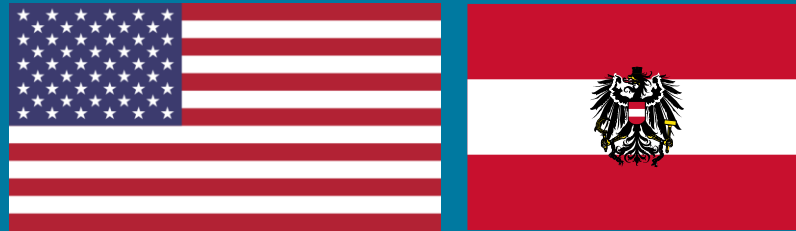

# Austria at a glance



- Area: 83 879 km<sup>2</sup> (32 386 sq miles)
- Population: 9.1 million > 90% are Austrians
- Federal Republic with 9 provinces, 8 neighbouring countries
- Capital: Vienna (Wien), 1.98 million inhabitants
- Languages: German + migrant and regional minority languages
- Religion: Christian (Catholic, some Lutherans)  
Islamic, Orthodox, Jewish & other minorities
- **380,000** higher education students  
**25 % foreign students** (90% from Europe)
- 3 main types of HEI, almost entirely public



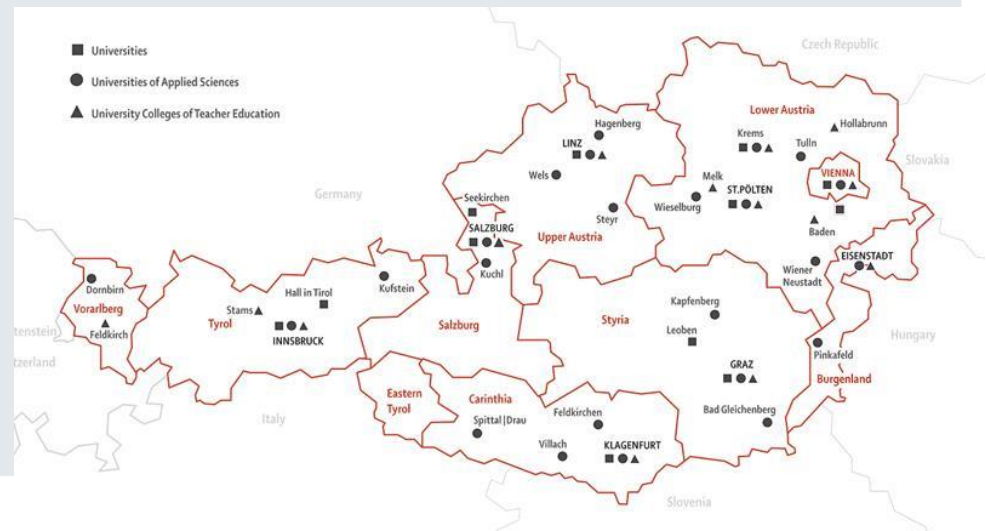
# Higher education in Austria

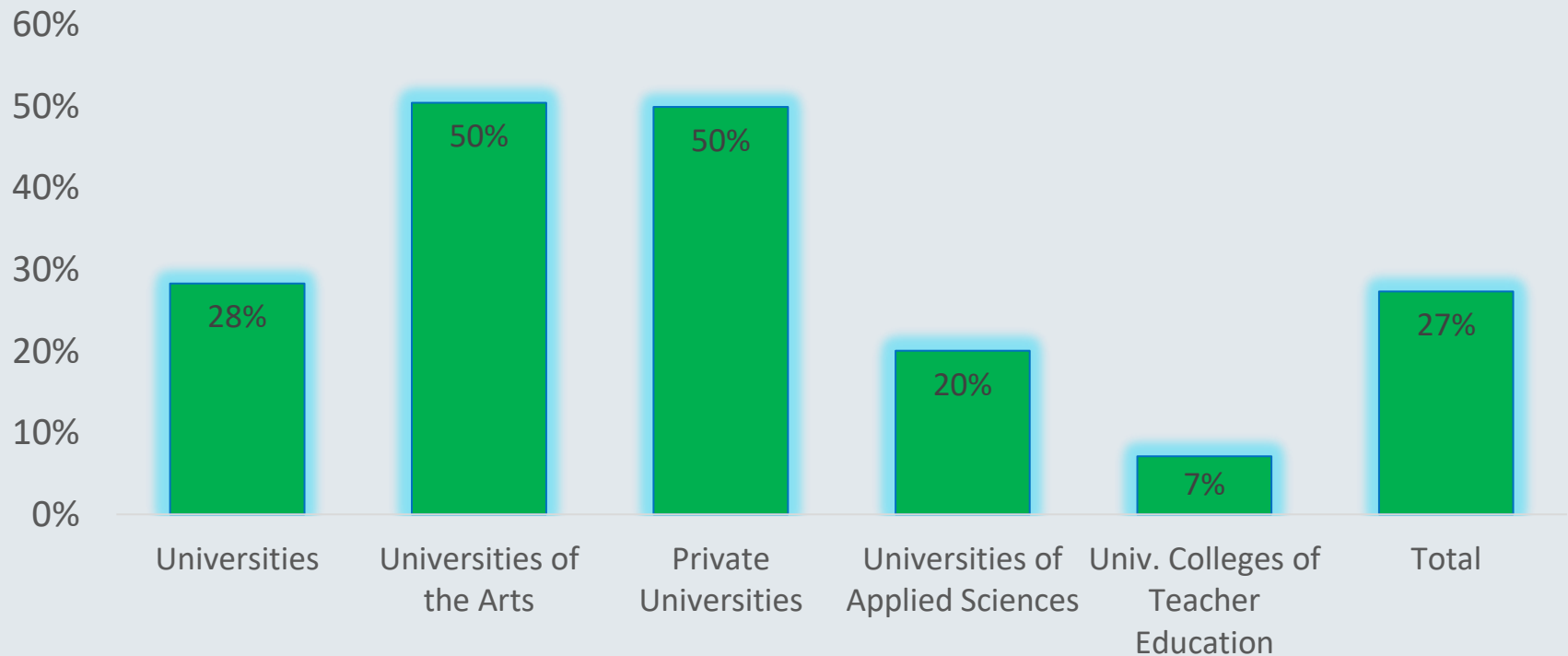

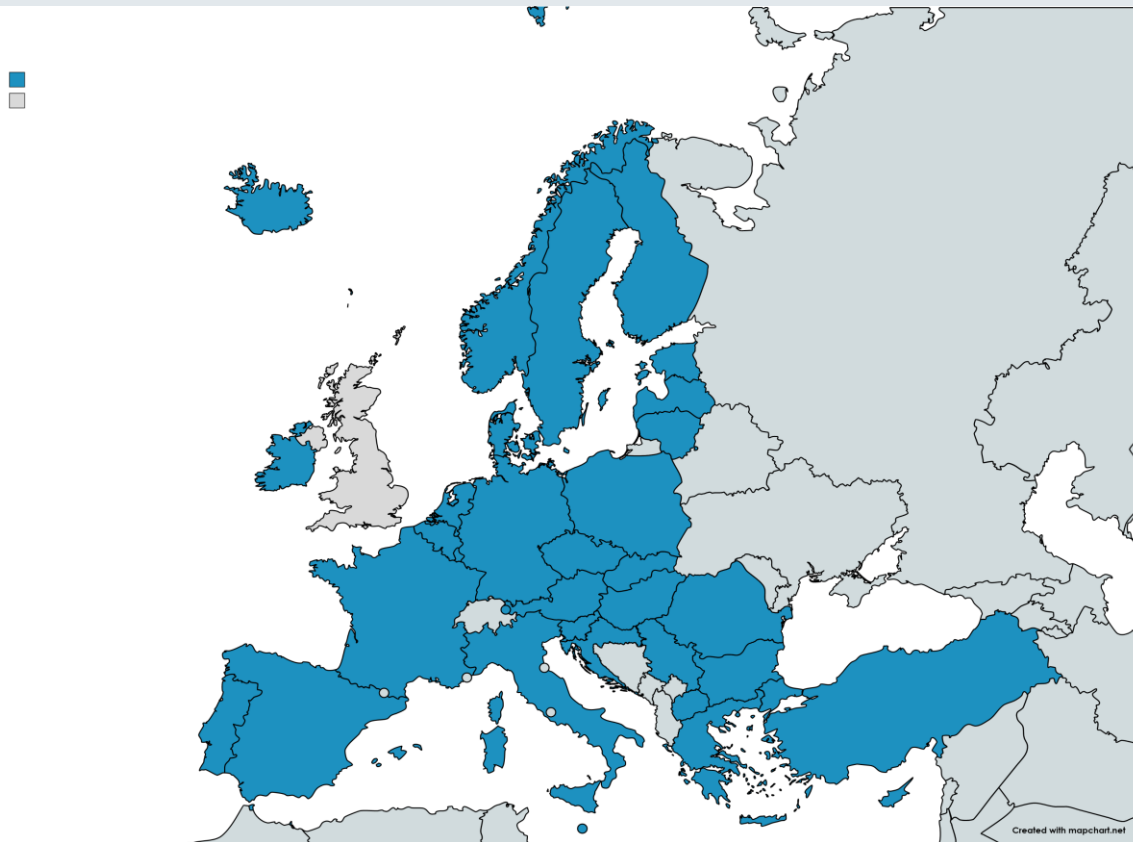

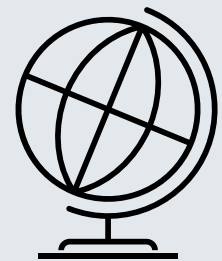

## Erasmus+ key facts

- So, why are we here?

Organizations from most countries in the world, including the USA, can take part in the program, eligibility depends on the specific opportunity



## Erasmus+ key facts



- Established in 1987 – in the first academic year about 3,200 students participated
- 1992 – Austria joined the program
- 2002 Erasmus+ reached its **One Millionth** student



## Erasmus+ key facts



- Budget for the period 2021 – 2027 about € 28 billions (\$ 30 billion), ~ 35 % for higher education
- Increase: more than € 10 billions (\$ 10.7 billions) compared to the previous period
- National co-funding (e.g. in Austria from the Federal Ministry for Education, Science and Research)
- In Austria for Erasmus+ Higher Education 2023:  
 EU funds: ~ € 31 millions (~ \$ 33 millions)  
 Co-funding by the ministry: ~ € 2 millions (~ \$ 2.1 millions)

## Further important program features

- Decentralized actions => in Austria managed by the OeAD

**KA1 – Mobility projects for students and staff**

KA2 – Cooperation partnerships

- Centralized actions => directly managed by the European Commission (e.g. Erasmus Mundus)



## Further important program features

- **KA1 – Mobility projects for students and staff**
  - => International Credit Mobility for students and staff (worldwide)
  - => Mobility of higher education for students and staff
    - Mobility generally limited to member countries
  - New:** Higher education institutions may use up to 20 % of the „intra-European“ funds for global outgoing mobilities = *international dimension including the USA*
- **For Austria in 2022: up to € 4.5 (\$ 4.8) millions additional funds for global outgoing mobilities**





## Further important program features

- Application deadline is in February or March, projects start in June or August
- Applications can only be submitted by the Austrian partners



## Further important program features

- Erasmus+ also offers mobilities for **non-academic professionals** at your institutions

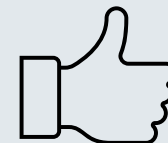

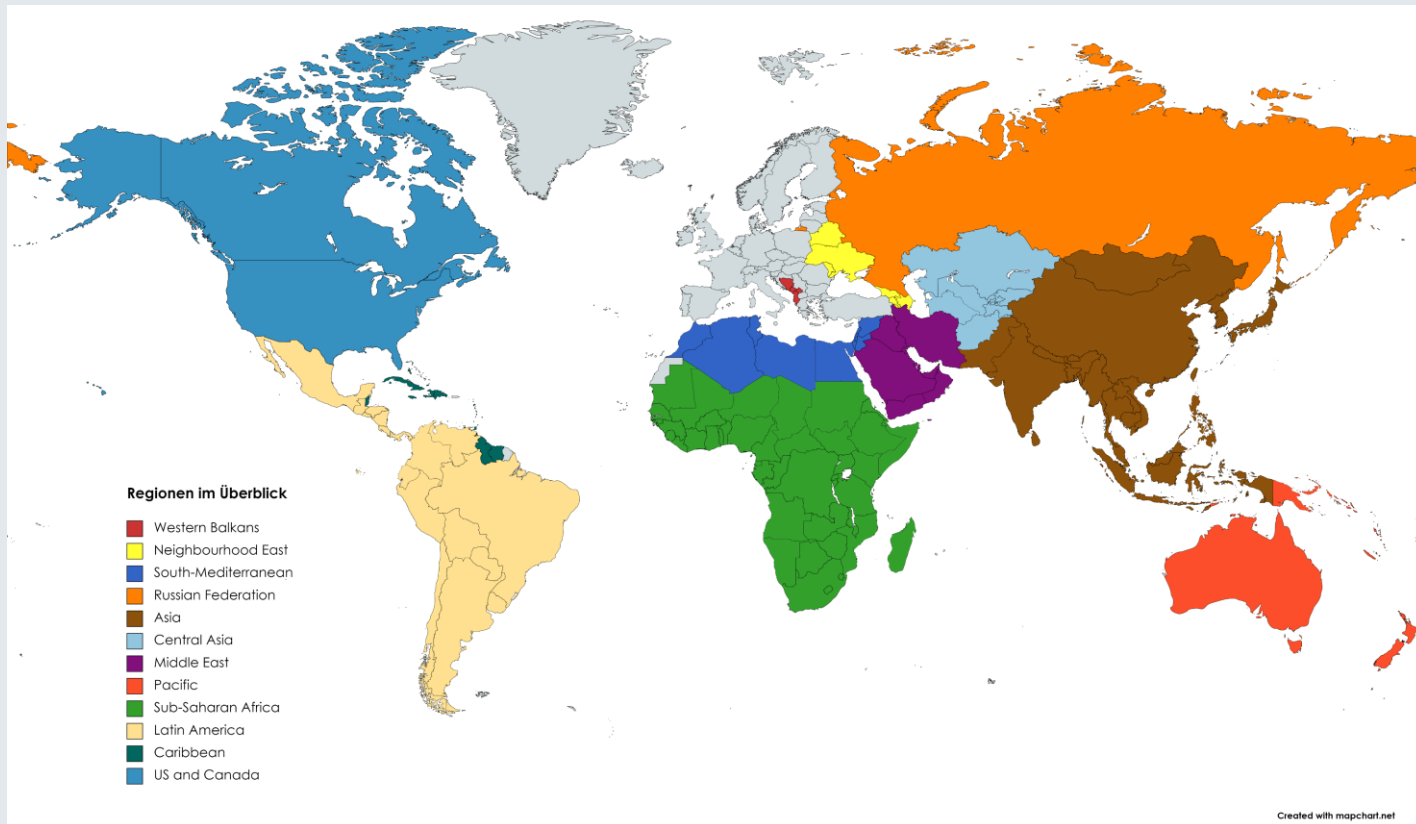

## KA171: Activity types for students

- Student mobility for studies (SMS)
  - Duration: 2 - 12 months
- Student mobility for traineeships (SMT)
  - Duration: 2 - 12 months
  - Traineeship for recent graduates
- Short-term mobilities with a compulsory virtual component (5 - 30 days)
- **Blended mobility:** virtual components in SMS and SMT

## KA171: Activity types for students

- Financial support
  - Incoming students to Austria: € 850 (\$ 910) per month
  - Outgoing students from Austria: € 700 (\$ 750) per month
  - for the USA, all mobility flows for all levels are possible
  - Travel grant calculation based on the distance between sending and receiving institution (“distance band”)
  - Institutions must ensure that no fees are charged for tuition, registration, examinations or access to facilities

## KA171: Activity types for HE staff

- Staff mobility for teaching/training (STA)/(STT)
  - Duration: 5 – 60 days
  - Teaching at partner universities
  - Staff training such as professional courses, staff training week, job shadowing, etc.
- Financial support
  - Outgoing staff from Austria: € 180 (\$ 192) per day
  - Incoming staff to Austria: € 160 (\$ 171) per day
  - Travel grant calculation based on the distance between sending and receiving institution („distance band“)



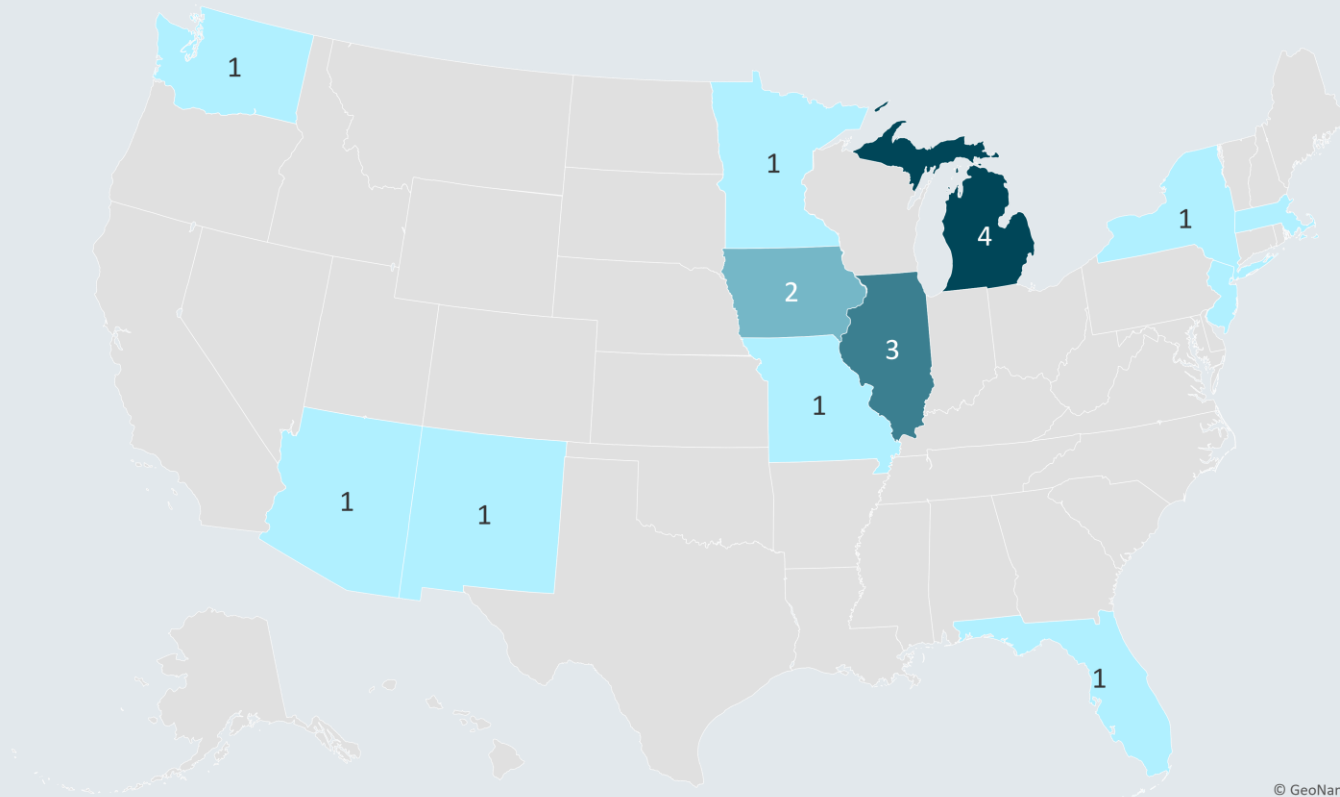

- 12 out of 31 Austrian universities have projects with 18 different US universities (Call 2022)

## Application process

- Annual call – next deadline planned **February 2024**
- Only **program country** HEIs (= Austrian) can **apply**
- **Cooperation** with **more than one HEI** within one region is **possible**
- Application text split up into three categories
- Short **texts** of approx. **1 – 2 pages** per category

## Category I

- Quality of the project design and cooperation arrangements
  - Who is **responsible** for the project **implementation** at both institutions?
  - How will **communication** work between the partners?
  - **Selection** procedure and criteria applied
  - **Support** for participants **before, during** and **after** the mobility at both institutions
  - How will the mobility be **recognized** at the sending institution

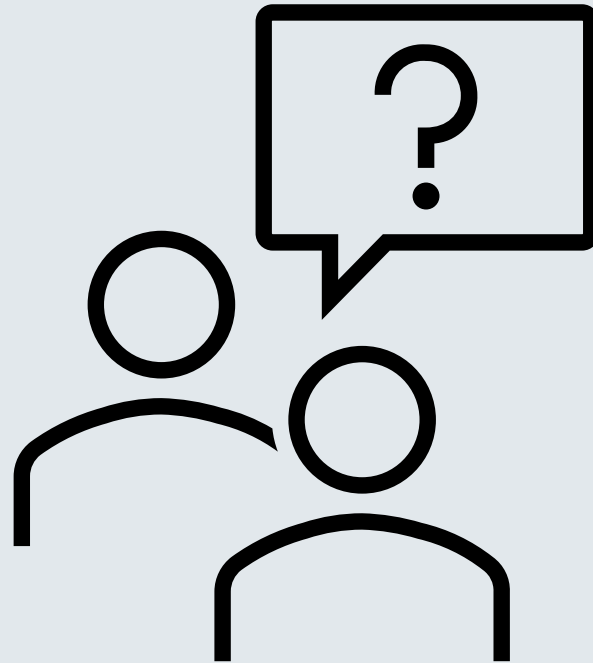
## Category II and III

- **Relevance** of the strategy (for every region)
  - Internationalization strategies of institutions and/or departments involved
  - Thematic content of the project
  - Why is the cooperation the “perfect match” for both partners?
- **Impact and dissemination** (for every region)
  - How will institutions, participants and (possibly) other sectors benefit from this cooperation?
  - How will the results be disseminated (conferences, events, papers, social media) > try to include meaningful and colourful examples

## Application: Things to keep in mind

- Take **your time** to prepare the application
- Get to know your partner and the **procedures in place** thoroughly (especially for new partners)
- Make use of **existing networks** and build upon **established partnerships**
- Start with **staff mobility** when targeting a new partner
- Important: application must contain perspectives and **positions of both institutions** in equal measure!

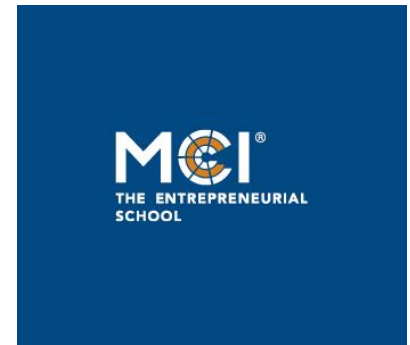

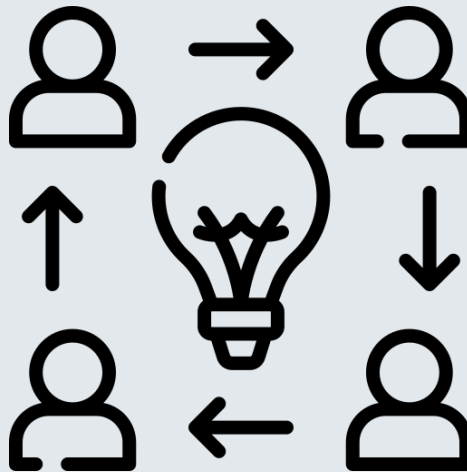

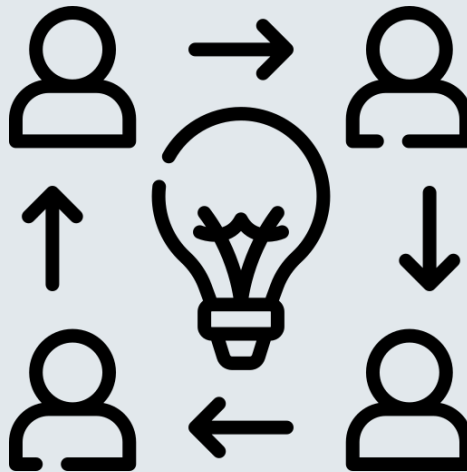
