What is the OeAD and Erasmus+?

- OeAD: Austrian Agency for cooperation in education
 - In Austria responsible for executing part of the Erasmus+ programme
- Erasmus+: the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe
 - Mobility and cooperation in the following fields:
 - higher education
 - vocational education and training
 - school education (including early childhood education and care)
 - adult education
 - youth
 - and sport

International Credit Mobility (ICM)

- Opportunity for mobilities to Austria or from Austria to countries outside of the “classical” Erasmus+ framework all over the world
- For students, academics and professional staff of Higher Education Institutions (HEI)
- Financial funding by European Commission between OeAD – HEI’s – Individuals

International Credit Mobility (ICM)

- Students (Bachelor, Master, PHD,...)
 - minimum 3 months academic stay
 - up to 850 Euro per month
 - Traineeship related to studies possible
 - minimum 2 months

International Credit Mobility (ICM)

- Professional staff:
 - teaching or training mobility abroad
 - minimum 5 days
 - up to 180 Euro per day
- How do I participate?
 - Bound to contracts between HEI's and OeAD
 - Your “home” HEI is your first point of contact

Erasmus Mundus (EM) -

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM) for HEIs

- target group: academics from HEIs
- EMJM supports high-level integrated transnational study programmes at Master's level for excellent students
- at least 3 HEIs from 3 different countries (at least 2 from Programme Countries: EU27, IS, LI, MK, NO, RS, TR)
- duration: 6 academic years
- funding for HEIs: 750 Euro/student/month (up to 124 students)
- total funding (scholarships next slide): up to 5.174.400 Euro

Erasmus Mundus (EM) -

Erasmus Mundus Joint Masters (EMJM) for students

- target group: potential Master's students
- EMJM offers full time scholarships for excellent students from all over the world participating in one of the selected EMJMs
- students need to study at least at 2 HEIs of the EMJM
- duration: 1 - 2 years depending on the EMJM
- funding for students: 1400 Euro/month (extra for up to 2 students with special needs: up to 120.000 Euro)

Erasmus Mundus (EM) - Erasmus Mundus Design Measures (EMDM)

- target group: academics from HEIs
- EMDM supports the development of new, innovative, high-level integrated transnational study programmes at Master level
- 1 HEI as beneficiary
- duration: 15 months
- funding for the HEI: 55.000 Euro

Jean Monnet Actions (JMA)

- target group: academics from HEIs
- 3 different JMA supports teaching and research in the field of EU studies worldwide

JM Modules	JM Chairs	JM Center of Excellence
min. 40h teaching/year	min. 90h teaching/year	research / teaching / think tank
30.000 Euro (75%)	50.000 Euro (75%)	100.000 (80%)

- 1 HEI as beneficiary
- duration of each action: 3 year

Capacity Building in Higher Education (CBHE)

- target group: academics from HEIs
- CBHE improves the quality of HE in partner countries and increases its relevance for the labor market and society
- at least 2 HEIs from 2 different Programme Countries (EU27, IS, LI, MK, NO, RS, TR) and at least 2 HEI from each non-industrialised Partner Country involved in the project
- duration: up to 4 years
- funding for HEIs: up to 800.000 Euro
