What is it?

- Established in 1949 by leading EU figures such as **Salvador de Madariaga**, **Winston Churchill**, **Paul Henri Spaak** and **Alcide de Gasperi** in the wake of the first Congress of the European Movement in The Hague in 1948.
- The idea was to establish an institute where university graduates from different European countries could **study and live together** in preparation for careers in European cooperation and integration.
- The first and oldest postgraduate institute of EU affairs.
- Three locations:
 - **Bruges**,
 - **Natolin/Warsaw**,
 - **Tirana**
- International community of more than 50 nationalities
- Bilingual institution: English - French
- Extensive network of alumni in Brussels and beyond (17.000 alumni)

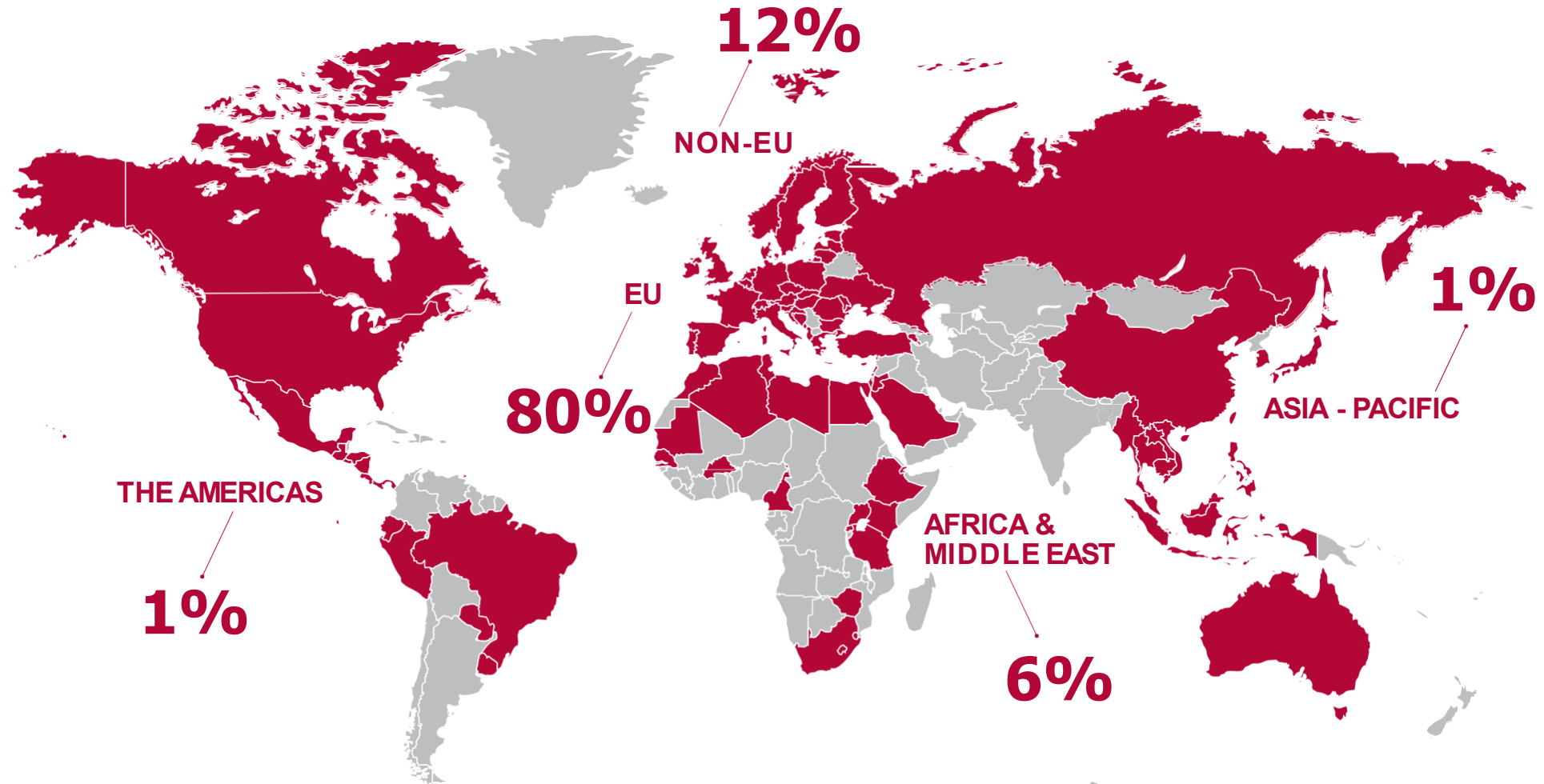

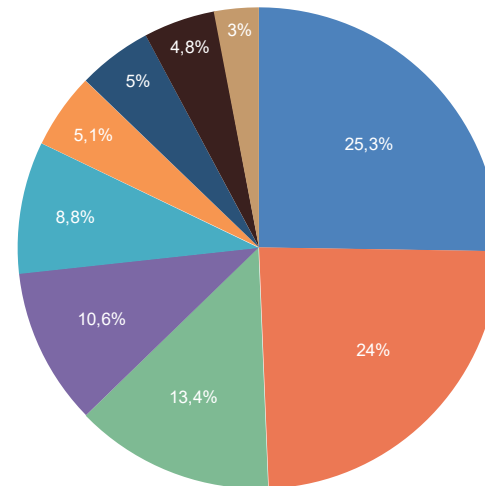

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- › All applicants to the College of Europe must hold a relevant university degree;
- › Admission requires either a Bologna Master's degree / 240 ECTS;
- › Exceptionally holders of a Bachelor degree are also eligible;
- › English and French are required (level may vary according to the study programme).

N.B: Requirements can vary on the department you are applying to.

APPLICATIONS PROCESS

OCTOBER TO JANUARY

- › Online application by the deadline (no fees charged)
 - Transcripts & CV
 - Personal qualities & activities
 - Motivation letter
 - 2 recommendation letters

MARCH TO MAY

- › Invitation for an interview in your home country or via videocall

MAY TO JUNE

- › Selection (with possible conditions)

JUNE TO JULY

- › Scholarship / payment information

AUGUST/SEPTEMBER

- › Start of the academic year
