Infrastructure or basic equipment of research institutions cannot be funded ○ The reimbursement for material costs is based on the form "reimbursement for material costs" and submitted invoices. We can only reimburse material costs, if all invoices and proofs of payments are provided in original. If necessary we return the original documents after they have been voided. Copies are only allowed for the proof of payment. ○ If the costs have been pre-financed by an institution which uses a SAP system or similar and the original documents have to be kept by the institution, a SAP statement or similar plus copies of the documents have to be provided. These documents must confirm that the copies are identical to the originals.
