

## **STEAM for Tomorrow: From Erasmus+ Results to Skills and Policy in Higher Education**

### **Location**

The STEAM conference takes place at [Johannes Kepler University \(JKU\) Linz](#) (see map on page 3). Most sessions, as well as lunch on Thursday and Friday, will take place at JKU Uni Center, only a short walk from the tram stop (about 25 minutes from the city centre). The location is wheelchair accessible. A campus map and further information on the conference location will be provided in due time.

### **Getting to Linz**

#### **Getting to Linz by plane**

Linz has a small international airport ([Linz Airport](#)), however, only very few airlines fly into Linz. Therefore, flying into Salzburg or Vienna might be both cheaper and more convenient. To get to Linz, take a train from either Salzburg or Vienna Airport.

From Salzburg Airport:

Take a bus from [Salzburg Airport](#) to Salzburg Main Station, then take a train from Salzburg Main Station to Linz Main Station. The route is served by both [Westbahn](#) and [ÖBB](#), make sure to purchase the correct ticket (duration approx. 1h 10 minutes).

From Vienna Airport:

Trains run directly from [Vienna Airport](#) to Linz Main Station; this direct connection is provided by [ÖBB](#) (duration approx. 1h 45 minutes).

#### **Getting to Linz by (night) train**

ÖBB trains connect Linz with many major European cities. There are also several night train connections that stop in Linz. Visit [ÖBB](#) or [ÖBB Nightjet](#) to find a connection.

### **Getting around Linz**

As Linz has a good and efficient network of tram lines, we strongly encourage you to use public transportation to get from Linz Main Station to your hotel and the conference location. Tramlines 1 and 2 run from Linz Main Station through the city centre to JKU, connecting the hotels in the city centre with the conference location.

Tickets can be purchased from the ticket machines or in the “LinzMobil-App”. You cannot buy tickets on the tram.

## Accommodation

We have made a pre-reservation in several hotels for 30-31 October. It is also possible to book an additional night before the conference. We recommend staying at a hotel that holds the [Austrian Ecolabel](#). Please find information on the hotels and booking modalities below:

### Hotel Schillerpark
