Important Dates for Pre-Study Programme Applicants

Registration VGUH courses: January 08 to February 21, 2018

Before registration, you have to do the mandatory electronic pre-registration:

public.vguh.at

After your online-pre-registration you have to come in person to the VGUH-office with your letter of acceptance and your passport to get your payment slip for the course fee and the login details for your student's account. Then please pay the course fee and bring your deposit slip to the VGUH-office 3-5 days after payment to get your personal data sheet for enrollment at your university. After enrollment at university and to complete your enrollment at the VGUH you have to send your confirmation of registration of your university electronically to office@vguh.at.

Note:

Separate registration procedures apply to students who have not received their letters of acceptance until February 21, 2018. Further information you will be given when registering at the VGUH-office.

If you register after March 15, a place in a regular course cannot be guaranteed, yet the semester counts as a registered semester. Note: Shorter courses cannot fully cover the teaching contents of regular courses. Also note the corresponding statement in the letter of acceptance of your university.

Mandatory Placement Tests for German: start from February 14, 2018

The tests will be held at **Neubaugasse 10**.

Important: You must register electronically before taking the test! This test is a mandatory requirement for admission to the VGUH. For any further information: See your student's account!

Course allocation:

After course allocation you will receive your timetable on your student's account. Course allocation is fixed, a change of course is not possible.

Study fee summer semester 2018 for regular students: € 300,- (to be paid not later than Feb. 21, 2018)

Please keep in mind: If you come here without any knowledge of German it might be very difficult to reach the required level in the German language assessment exam within the time allowed by the university administration (Letter of Acceptance).

Required rate of attendance in courses: 80%. Observe the requirements for the issue of a course certificate.

Registration for exams: see public.vguh.at, the info-board at VGUH or VGUH-homepage

Certificates: issued not before three days after oral exam, at VGUH-office

Examination weeks: Feb. 26 – March 09, 2018

First German language assessment exam (=Ergänzungsprüfung Deutsch: EPD): **Examination fee: € 30.-**

The exam consists of a written and an oral part:

Written exam: Feb. 26, 2018

Oral exam: March 02, 2018 (on the premises of a positive written exam)

Beginning of courses: March 05, 2018

For further information check your student's account / public.vguh.at (after course allocation)!

End of courses: June 29, 2018

End of semester: July 06, 2018

Further examination weeks: Mid-March 2018, end of June 2018

Registration for beginners:

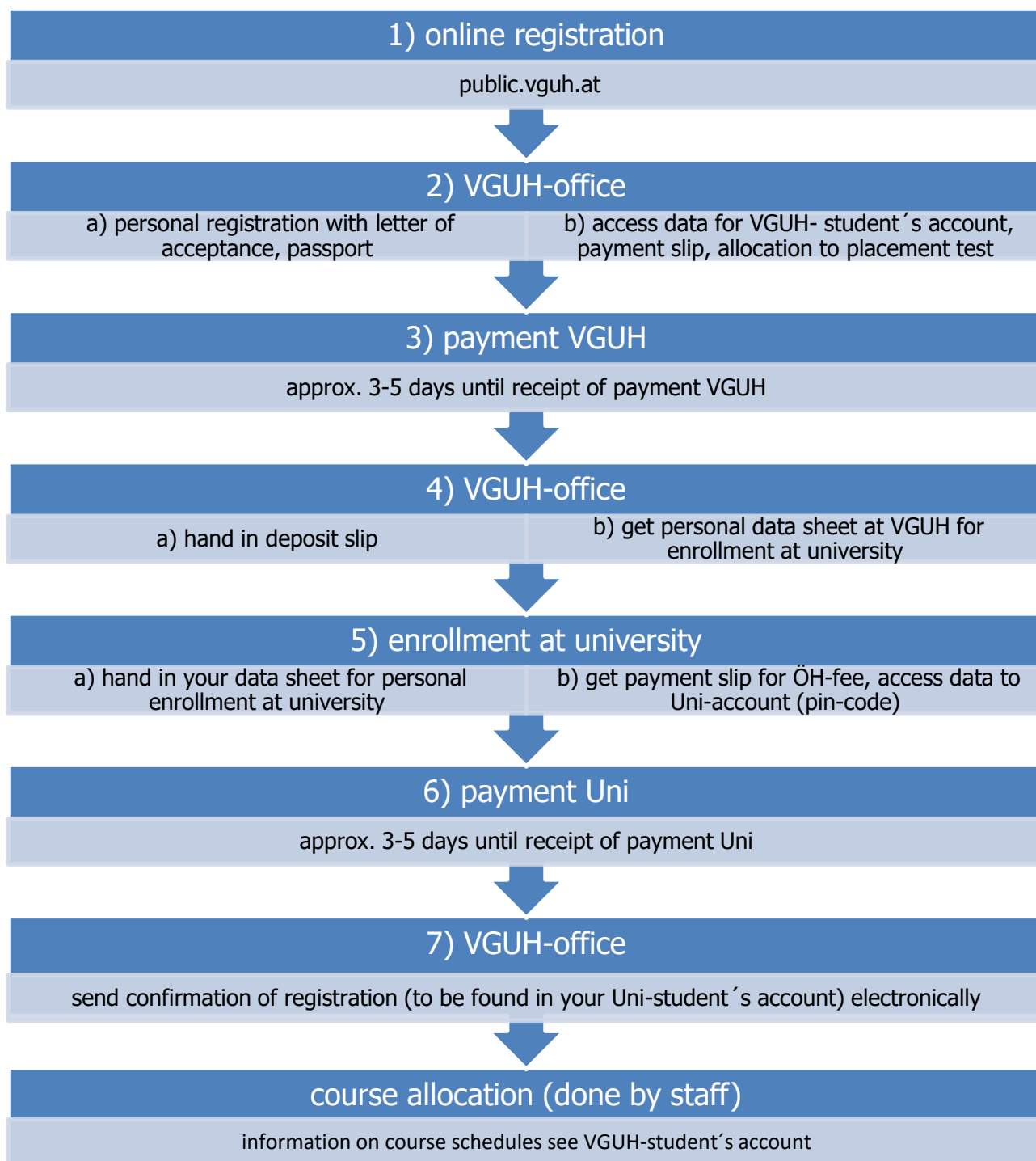
General admission period SS 18:
