Many decades ago, the international community decided to stop large-scale deaths of civilians during wars and armed conflicts. Thus the rules of war were created, which forbade the killing of civilians, the infliction of harm and torture on prisoners, and the launching of lethal weapons into unprotected settlements.

Despite the fact that the rules of war are set out in international treaties such as the Geneva Conventions, the Rome Statute, and other international laws and agreements, many of which Russia is a signatory to.





## Sanctions #Erasmuswithoutrussia – at the link

- Erasmus+ projects with russia and belarus are terminated!
- The cooperation with organisations funded by the state budget is NOT eligible The individual opportunities for russians/belorusions\* are still eligible if applicable. Based on its Academic/organisational Freedom it is up to the Erasmus Universities and other organisations on how to apply it.



- At least ask the attitude to the russian war against Ukraine when they apply/arrive...it is nothing to do with politics!
- Please do the right choice choose people from Ukraine, we are defending the future of Europe!
- **PLEASE DO NOT** provide similarities via joint **support** platforms for Ukrainians, Russians, and Belarusians: do not equal those suffering from a bloody war with those whose governments directly support war and terrorism -'victims of war'  $\neq$  'victims of totalitarian regime'. \*Without any prejudice to the nationalities issues!!!
- Ukrainians are not refugees not refused by our country... but temporary relocated internally/abroad.
- Stop recognition of russian diplomas, they are not in Bologna Process any more!
- Do not put students and staff from Ukraine and from Russia/ belarus\* in one event do not traumatize!!!

- ✓ 24 regions of Ukraine are providing education in distance learning format!





- Force Majeure Circumstances: suspend or continue with redesigning

Special measures guide for mobility details – download

The Erasmus+ projects involving Ukrainian students and higher education staff are granted the greatest level of flexibility in the implementation. This will allow beneficiaries to cancel, postpone or move activities planned in the most flexible way.

Eligible activities: The activities have to take place at the beneficiary HEI. In cases when, due to the war, the sending organisation cannot be involved in the activity, the beneficiary HEI is the only HEI involved in the organisation of the mobility, except for traineeships outside of the HEI.

## Important for Erasmus+ partners

How to cope with challenges and limits for male students and staff and specific categories of women participation in Erasmus+

### The specific categories of students and staff of 18-60 years old are **not allowed to cross the border** with some exceptions!!!

- University students are exempt from mobilization for the study period!!!
- However, it does not provide permission for the border crossing!!!
- For short term participation (2-3 weeks) of staff and students in Erasmus+ KA1&KA2 projects activities abroad, the Ukrainian HEIs shall apply to MoESU for request letter to State Border Control Service of Ukraine
- Follow up with State Border Control Service of Ukraine by home university about decision is a must.
- The final decision is taken by the State Border Control Service based on the provided documents. *The documents package include:*
- Enrolment/Admission/ Acceptance for Students; Invitation letter for staff; Students card or students visa Additionally: Mobility Agreement, Inter-Institutional Agreements, Nomination letter, Student's Card, Health Insurance Certificate, UA University and Ministry request letters etc. (depending on the type of mobility).
- Certificate from the Military Service Center of Ukraine and other obligatory documents

Please consider the risks of the delay of arrival or cancelation!!! Discuss possible solutions: the blended format or postpone of the mobility for such students/staff/ youth, if possible, or give preference to female or males who are already abroad!

### RUSSIA'S WAR ON UKRAINE: UKRAINIAN STUDENTS IN THE EU



Russia's invasion of Ukraine on 24 February 2022 has caused vast displacement of people within the country as well as across the EU borders. While the annexation of Crimea had a negative impact on the country's education system, recent events have added additional strain.

Outbound student mobility was already substantial in recent years, but it has accelerated even further since the Crimean conflict began. After doubling from some 25 000 to nearly 50 000 between 2007 and 2014, the number of Ukrainian students abroad has since skyrocketed by another 54 % to around 78 000 in 2019.

Approximately 49 000 Ukrainian students were attending various higher education institutions across the EU in 2019. This means that approximately 60 % of the 78 000 Ukrainians studying abroad worldwide in 2019 chose to study in the EU. The countries welcoming the highest numbers of students are Poland, Germany, Czechia and Slovakia.

Some 480 Ukrainian students are currently engaged in Erasmus+ activities via the programme's international strand. In the 2015-2019 programming period, Ukraine received 40 % of the available funding in the Eastern Partnership region, and over 9 000 Ukrainian students and staff participated in more than 1 300 Erasmus projects.

Following the Russian invasion of Ukraine, Commissioner Mariya Gabriel announced, on 2 March 2022, that the Commission would grant maximum flexibility in the implementation of Erasmus+ projects involving Ukrainian



Ukrainian students worldwide Number of young people studying worldwide





## **Needs: Erasmus+ Programme level**






