The OeAD's representation in China, strategically integrated within the Austrian Consulate General Shanghai, has built upon its long-standing presence to cultivate an extensive network of partners throughout China.

By further enhancing its expertise in China, it assists Austrian universities and universities of applied sciences in negotiating cooperative opportunities, facilitating the establishment of reciprocal partnerships.

In engaging in nearly all aspects of academic exchange, the office facilitates comprehensive academic exchanges. It also provides guidance to Austrian academic admission offices and coordinates the cooperation with the Academic Evaluation Centres (APS) in China. Additionally, it fosters the development of China-related expertise in Austria through workshops and briefings.

The office regularly hosts webinars and in-person events for Chinese educators to enhance Austria's position in the field of German as a foreign language within China. Another key objective is to strengthen ties between Austria and its Chinese alumni through networking events.

Furthermore, the office manages delegation visits, organises fairs for Austrian educational institutions at Chinese high schools and universities and organises study trips to China. This allows students from Austria to gain valuable experience and acquire not only specialised knowledge but also intercultural competencies.
