Support of projects in Education, Science and Research

The OeAD-Cooperation Office, based at the Austrian Consulate General in Shanghai, assists in founding new academic cooperations projects between Austria and China. It also supports the process of their implementation. Other important objectives include strengthening ties between Austria and its Chinese alumni, supporting Austrian educational institutions in implementing their marketing initiatives in China, and promoting Austrian-specific content in DaF (German as a Foreign Language) education in China.
