

As an agency of the Republic of Austria the OeAD contributes to inclusive, equal and high-quality education on behalf of the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research.

OeAD staff work in Austria, Europe and internationally in priority countries. They advise, support and connect people and institutions in education, science, research and culture with our future-oriented programmes. The OeAD supports internationalisation in Austria by implementing programmes such as Erasmus+, the European Solidarity Corps (ESC) and CEEPUS. The OeAD acts as an interface for educational offers for everyone: kindergartens, schools, higher education and science, vocational education and adult education, youth and sport.

The OeAD has an extensive network of contacts within the EU and in the geographical focus regions of the Western Balkans, the EU's neighbouring countries in the East, Southeast Asia, China and Africa. We advise stakeholders in education, higher education and development policy and provide support in the context of development cooperation and science diplomacy.

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OEAD COOPERATION OFFICES ABROAD

The OeAD has a network of cooperation offices in priority regions of the Austrian educational and scientific cooperation.



To support sustainable education reforms in our partner countries the OeAD works together with more than **500 educational institutions** in around **20 projects** per year in various areas of educational reform.

Cooperation offices

The OeAD has cooperation offices for pre-university education in Chişinău, Odesa/Uzhhorod, Sarajevo (responsible for Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, Serbia) and Tirana (responsible for Albania, Kosovo, North Macedonia).


The offices are headed by Austrian educational coordinators, who are directly seconded by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research (BMBWF).

Focus on scientific cooperation in higher education

The OeAD cooperation offices in **Lviv** and **Shanghai** focus on supporting mobility, networking and cooperation in higher education. They cooperate with local institutions in science, education and culture.

What they do:

- Providing strategic advice and support for institutions in higher education in the initiation of institutional cooperation
- Advising students, scientists and researchers from abroad who wish to spend a study or research period in Austria

Marietta Blau Scholarship

The Marietta Blau Scholarship supports six- to twelve-month stays abroad for doctoral and PhD students at Austrian universities. It serves to optimise the content of doctoral theses through relevant research work abroad and in particular supports young academics.

Austria Centres

There are now nine Austria Centres the aim of which is to support research and knowledge about Austria and Central Europe. In cooperation with Austrian universities and other scientific or cultural institutions they promote scientific cooperation between the respective country and Austria.

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FOCUS AUSTria and Languages

The OeAD promotes teaching of **German as a foreign language** and conveying a **modern image of Austria** abroad. Language in particular is used as a gateway to a globalised world.

What is done:

- Around 110 lecturers at more than 90 locations worldwide
- More than 160 language assistants at schools in nine countries
- Partner network "Kultur und Sprache" with more than 30 institutions of pre- and in-service training of German teachers in 16 countries



The OeAD carries out various coordinating and administrative activities in these three regional university networks: ASEA-UNINET, EurasiaPacific Uninet (EPU) and Africa UniNet. Funding for project cooperations is provided by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Education, Science and Research (BMBWF).



ASEAN-European Academic University Network (ASEA-UNINET)

- * Network of more than 90 European and Southeast Asian universities in 16 countries
- + Founded in 1994
- + Objective: promoting the continuous internationalisation of education and research by means of scholarships and projects
- + Funding of up to 80 research and teaching projects per year with Austrian participation as well as numerous scholarships for study and research activities in Austria

Austrian-African Research Network (Africa-UniNet)

- + Network of more than 69 institutions, 43 of which in 17 African countries and 26 in Austria.
- + Initiated in 2019 by the BMBWF, the OeAD and the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences (BOKU)
- + Objective: providing a stable basis for project cooperation between Austrian and African universities and research institutions

Eurasia-Pacific Uninet Network (EPU)

- Network with approximately 160 member institutions from 15 countries of the Asian region
- + Founded in 2000
- + Objective: connecting higher education and research institutions in the partner countries



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
