Speaker

Mr. Subodh Sharma completed his PhD ›Biological Assessment of Water Quality in the Rivers of Nepal‹ at the University of Natural Resources & Life Sciences (BOKU) in 1996 within the North-South Dialogue Scholarship Programme, financed by the Austrian Development Cooperation (ADC). He developed an assessment tool to evaluate the ecological status of rivers for Nepal, later expanded this tool to assess the quality of Himalayan rivers in Bhutan, Bangladesh, Northern India, and Northern Pakistan.

Now, Dr. Sharma is a University Professor at the Department of Environmental Science & Engineering in Kathmandu University, Nepal. He is also Director of Aquatic Ecology Centre, a centre established in 2003 in collaboration with BOKU.
