Since the start of the project in September 2008, 266 pupils - from three educational establishments – have participated in the SKY-self-assurance training. The training was operated by Clinical Psychologists and Health Psychologists who were SKY-associates and it was based on current academic standards. The training's intent is to deliver insight into state-of-the-art scientific knowledge about shyness and social phobia to youths.

Based on various parts of the project (self-assurance training, schooling of peer-self-assurance-trainers, excursions to the Research and Training Practice of Vienna University, interdisciplinary workshops), several issues were carried out together with pupils and teachers of the participating schools: "Scientific Psychology", Research, Shyness, and Social Anxiety. Teaching relaxation exercises, as well as to impart knowledge about cognitive models and doing role-plays regarding social anxiety was seen favourably by the young people concerned. They became acquainted with psychological interventions and were able to pose questions directly to the SKY-Team.

There were several specific courses at BAKIP Steyr to deliver insight into clinical psychological research to the youths (how to generate hypothesis out of a scientific question, data acquisition and scientific knowledge). At the other participating schools these issues are being elaborated and presented together with the youths in an age-based way.

Over the last few months several excursions to the Research and Training Practice of Vienna University also took place. The pupils could experience the day-to-day clinical psychological research very closely and had the opportunity for example to test Bio-feedback for themselves. Several pupils from BAKIP Steyr even had the possibility to join an academic course of the Psychological Institute ("Innovative Developments in Clinical Psychology") – they gave a presentation for Viennese Psychology students, reporting facts about and experiences with the SKY-self-assurance training.

The schooling of peer-self-assurance-trainers especially appealed to the participating schools. Within the scope of these workshops the youths were taught the basics in cognitive principles of Clinical Psychology, relaxation-exercises, and some details concerning anamnesis interviews. The peer-trainers are important points of contact for young people with difficulties in self-esteem and self-assurance.
