A warm welcome to Vienna – Practicalities

Weather

The average temperature in Vienna in April is between 9°c and 17°c so it will be a surprise. It can be cold and rainy or warm spring weather. We advise you to be prepared for both.

Vienna Airport --> City of Vienna / City of Vienna --> Vienna Airport

Vienna has a large airport (VIE) connecting many destinations with many airlines.

Going to the city centre by train, you can either fall for the little tourist trap **CAT-Train**, which takes you hardly quicker but much more expensive (19,92 EUR) to the central station OR you take a **regional train (RJ, RJX or REX)** for 4,30 EUR to the central station. There is also a <u>bus</u> every 30 min from the airport to Vienna central station: **Bus VAL 1** (€ 9,50 one way, you can get the tickets directly from the driver or <u>online</u>, departing at XX:00 and XX:30).

If you happen to arrive very late or need to depart very early (when there are no train connections anymore/yet), you can exceptionally order an Airport Taxi (at least 24 in advance) for a fix price.

Please pay attention that you can't use the Vienna public transport ticket to and from the airport as the airport is outside of Vienna! You must buy your ticket to/from the airport either online at the ÖBB website or at a (also red) ÖBB ticket vending machine directly at the airport/at Vienna central station.



















Vienna: Getting around



Public Transportation in Vienna is great. The **Wiener Linien** has closely timed schedule and hardly any delays, which makes getting around comfortable. The public transport tickets include transportation by bus, U-Bahn, S-Bahn and tram.

Network plan:

The easiest way to find your route **online** is on **google maps**.

Purchasing Tickets:

You can purchase your tickets online.

We suggest buying a **48h** or **72 h ticket** (14,10 EUR / 17,10 EUR), depending on how long you are staying. Direct link to the 48h/72 h ticket: https://shop.wienmobil.at/products/244872_VIE

You can also purchase a **paper ticket** at one of these beautiful red ticket vending machines (photo).

Pay attention, that if you are travelling with a **paper ticket**, you need to stamp it in order to *validate* it in the **blue ticket stampers** *before* **boarding.** *So, don't forget to validate your ticket!*

- U-Bahn station **Dresdner Straße** (5 min walking)

















Accommodation

IBIS Hotel (located directly at the central railway station)

From Central Station to the IBIS Hotel walk 1-2 minutes.

From IBIS Hotel to the Conference/Meeting venue UAS Technikum Wien take S1 / S2 / S4 / REX 1 / REX 3 from Vienna Central Station to *Traisengasse* (about 14 min) and walk 8 min to the venue.

Hotel Rathauspark (close to city centre)

Rathausstraße 17, 1010 Wien / +43 1 40 412

From Vienna Central Station (Hauptbahnhof Ost S) to Hotel Rathauspart take **Tram D** direction Nußdorf to *Rathausplatz, Burgtheater* (28 min, 11 stops) and walk the last meters. Tram D departs every 8 minutes.

From Hotel Rathauspark to the Conference/Meeting venue UAS Technikum Wien take tram 33 direction Friedrich-Engels-Platz from *Lange Gasse* (10 min walk) to *Höchstädtplatz* (17 min, 10 stops) and then walk the last meters (27 min in total).

Tram 33 departs every 12 minutes at XX:10, XX:22, XX:34, XX:46 and so on.

Dinner on Tuesday, 25 April, 8 p.m., Uraniastraße 1, 1010 Vienna

We are happy to invite you to an informal dinner at KLYO.

The impressive building hosts a cinema, a restaurant, an astronomical observatory, a famous puppet theater (Kasperltheater) and a branch of an adult education centre (Volkshochschule).

It's located at the popular Danube Canal in the city centre.
